<p><b>Overall purpose</b></p> <p>The Senior Financial Systems and Data Analyst will support the development, maintenance, and optimization of GAIN's financial systems and databases and related processes across the organisation.</p> <p>Reporting to the Senior Manager, Financial Systems &amp; Analysis, the postholder will lead on system integrations and will propose and implement process improvements specifically related to our financial systems and connections to our other data sources.</p> <p>Working in close collaboration with the International Finance Team, this position will play a key role in setting up integrations between systems, managing large financial datasets, ensuring the accuracy, integrity and efficiency of financial data and reporting tools to support efficient data-driven decision-making and compliance.</p>
<p><u>Data Structure Optimization and Maintenance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Oversee and maintain the structural financial coding of the full project lifecycle across various systems, from project initiation to close-out.</li> <li>• Administer and maintain GAIN's data model, user permissions and approval roles, and coding structures across platforms.</li> <li>• Propose and implement processes for streamlining financial data processes and integrations between financial systems and other platforms, including GAIN's CRM (Salesforce), forecasting tool (Vena), SharePoint, and SQL.</li> <li>• Ensure the accuracy and integrity of all financial reporting and integrations.</li> <li>• Support major system transitions and upgrades, including the implementation of new coding frameworks and ERP upgrades.</li> <li>• Maintain exchange rates and ensure accurate currency conversions in core accounting systems.</li> </ul> <p><u>Forecasting &amp; Planning Support</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Manage and optimize workflows related to financial forecasting, including task assignments, workflow structure, and data consolidation.</li> <li>• Provide technical support for Excel and Vena-based reporting structures, including managing formulas, data sources, and system configurations for dynamic planning tools.</li> <li>• Manage major data imports related to financial forecasting.</li> </ul>

### Staff Cost and Accounting Support

- Oversee the daily and monthly timesheet processes using Power Automate, ensuring data is collected, validated, and integrated into financial systems.
- Develop and manage templates and uploads for salary, fringe, vacation accruals, and other compensation data across reporting periods.
- Produce and manage uploads and import files for retroactive pay, pay increases, and one-time payments.
- Facilitate the monthly accounting process by preparing and uploading timesheet and staff cost data to financial systems.
- Coordinate data sharing and reporting with Finance team members to ensure accurate and timely financial reporting.

### Continuous Improvement & Technical Support

- Identify system issues or inefficiencies and recommend solutions and opportunities to streamline and improve system workflows, automate repetitive tasks, and enhance data accuracy.
- Provide technical support for custom reporting, data refreshes, and system troubleshooting, investigating and resolving system issues.
- Collaborate cross-functionally with IT, HR, and Finance to ensure systems are meeting business needs.
- Collaborate with Finance and IT teams to implement system upgrades, patches, and enhancements
- Document system configurations, procedures, and user guides
- Other key duties as requested by the Senior Manager, Financial Systems and Analysis

### **Key organisational relationships**

- Reports to the Senior Manager, Financial Systems and Analysis
- Works in close collaboration with the International Finance Team including the Chief Financial Officer, Corporate Finance managers, Senior Associates, Financial Systems and Operations and Financial Reporting.
- Partner with country finance and programme staff across GAIN offices.

### **Competencies**

- Capacity to work across systems and manage large datasets.
- Advanced proficiency in Microsoft Excel (Power Query, formula writing, etc.)
- Proficiency in Power Automate or similar workflow automation tools.
- Strong technical and analytical skills with experience in data integration and system configuration.
- Highly effective organisation and planning skills with the ability to manage multiple competing priorities.
- High level of financial literacy, with demonstrable ability to analyse and interpret financial reports and data.
- Excellent analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Attention to detail and a commitment to continuous improvement. Ability to communicate technical concepts to non-technical users
- Knowledge of data privacy and internal control standards (e.g., SOX compliance) is a plus.
- An enthusiastic team player but able to work independently as required.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills.
- Strong understanding of financial principles and accounting processes.
- Ability to collaborate with teams in a matrix and multi-cultural environment.

**Experience**

- Proven experience in previous finance systems, databases, or data analysis role with technical experience in data integration and system configuration.
- Demonstrable experience with process improvement and system implementation.
- Significant experience of using a range of financial databases and software reporting tools, and ERP/ accounting systems (such as Microsoft Dynamics NAV and SQL), to produce or deliver financial reports and analyses. Experience in using Vena or Salesforce is an advantage.
- Experience supporting accounting and payroll workflows, as well as forecasting functions within financial systems, with an understanding of financial reporting cycles.
- Experience of working within a multi-country, multi-office, multi-cultural environment.
- SQL scripting and database management experience.
- ERP implementation or financial system upgrade experience.
- Familiarity with API integrations or middleware platforms.

- Bachelor's degree in information systems, Computer Science, Accounting, Finance, or a related field.

- Fluent written and verbal English.
- Must be willing to work in alignment with Geneva time zone work hours to enable collaboration across time zones.
