The Global Alliance for Improved Nutrition (GAIN) is a Swiss-based foundation launched at the UN in 2002 to tackle the human suffering caused by malnutrition. Overall purpose

GAIN fights malnutrition in Ethiopia through innovative and sustainable models that increase access to affordable nutritious foods among communities vulnerable to malnutrition.

The Better Dairy for All project is designed to develop solutions that increase access (including through supports on innovative dairy processing) and demand to affordable dairy products for children <7 years, pregnant and lactating women, school children, and low wage industrial or large-scale farm workers. This is achieved through the improvement of access to affordable and safe dairy products by building on existing dairy value chain in Amhara and other regions of Ethiopia.

The Project Manager is responsible for the effective implementation of the project and will lead the project team in generating demand for dairy products to be consumed by the target groups, developing affordable, safe, and nutritious prototypes of dairy or dairy-based products, developing a viable business model as well as a marketing and demand creation strategy. The project will provide technical support to milk/dairy processors and distributers to make safe and affordable milk/dairy products available and developing and implementing a viable school dairy feeding strategy. In addition, the Project Manager will ensure the project's achievements are monitored, tracked, and documented in a timely manner.

The Project Manager will also lead efforts to strengthen the enabling environment for value addition towards dairy accessing and consumption in Ethiopia.

Tasks and responsibilities

Project Management

- Accountable for the overall effective management of the project activities with emphasis on access and demand.
- Plan, implement, monitor and track the project outputs.

- Collaborate with partners to identify influencing agendas, engaging with key opinion leaders, professionals, and policy makers on optimal feeding through improving dairy access, demand and mitigating other consumption issues.

- Provide the required technical supports to selected dairy processors and distributers to make safe and quality dairy products accessible to target community
