Reporting to the SFS Senior Project Manager, the Financial Development Associate manages the SFS project grants, identifying constraints, designing and facilitating financial solutions to help the grantees to keep the investment and the business on track, supporting the delivery of GAIN's strategic plan for the SFS to be implemented in Cabo Delgado.

About the Sustainable Food System Project (SFS): This project aims primarily to strengthen and repair the local food system in the southern segment of Cabo Delgado province, which has been severely impacted by conflict, drought, and long-standing under-investment. Ultimately, the project seeks to protect the consumption of the poorer residents of five vulnerable districts, including internally displaced persons from conflict areas and their hosts, with actions to improve both the availability and the affordability of safe and nutritious foods in their communities.

Tasks and responsibilities

Project Management

- Evaluate grantees business start-up and expansion needs
- Elaborates the investment plans for each grantee
- Assist the grantees business modelling and development of operational plans
- Collect accurate data from ratio analysis, trends, cash flows, income statements and balance sheets and provide support to grantee to interpret the data
- Assess financial projections and business plans of GAIN SFS grantees
- Make recommendations to grantees management regarding necessary changes to company policies that can affect the financial performance and compliance
- Track business performance and outcomes in the database prepared for each grantee
- Elaborate regular reports regarding grantees business progress and impact at local food systems
- Provides business development assistance to SFS grantees as requested by the Senior project manager
