The Global Alliance for Improved Nutrition (GAIN) is a Swiss-based foundation launched at the UN in 2002 to tackle the human suffering caused by malnutrition. Working with both governments and businesses, we aim to transform food systems so that they deliver more nutritious food for all people. In particular, we aim to make healthier food choices more desirable, more available, and more affordable. GAIN's mission is to advance nutrition outcomes by improving consumption of nutritious and safe food for all people, especially the most vulnerable to malnutrition.

DESCRIPTION

Overall purpose

The current data access and data use barriers constrain decision makers' capacity to design and implement coherent food systems policy, plans, and activities; realize participatory food systems 'good governance'. Jointly, the inability to undertake these actions limits progress towards achieving the SDGs and other important national targets. The GAIN solution to this problem is to collaborate with subnational governments and urban municipalities to build country food systems dashboards displaying sub-national data (e.g. city level and broader sub-national level data), providing access to evidence in one place to support data-informed decision-making. Well-curated, national-level data are already available for over 230 countries through the Food Systems Dashboard (FSD). However, it does not currently display disaggregated, city and subnational-level data for country food systems.

It is expected that the country dashboards will be the first place that local decision makers (from government, municipalities, NGOs, civil society, donors, UN, and academia/research) go to, to find curated, high-quality, filtered national, subnational and city-level data and analytics on their country's food system. Our aim is to have the country dashboards adopted as the main data platforms to inform and shape national and/or city strategic plans as well as national Food Systems Dialogues and UN Food Systems Summit action-tracking work. The dashboards are also expected to be used as a tool to track progress and accountability against national/local commitments or action plans that support food systems transformation. This will benefit people in Bangladesh at risk of hunger, malnutrition, food system job losses, climate change, and environmental degradation.

The Program Assistant will support the work under this initiative for Bangladesh and provide support to technical leadership and project management. The post-holder will be expected to compile, manage and analyze data and maintain strong relationships with relevant partners, the government and other stakeholders to support Project Manager in implementing the project.

Tasks and responsibilities

Project Management
