The Global Alliance for Improved Nutrition (GAIN) is a Swiss-based foundation launched at the UN in 2002 to tackle the human suffering caused by malnutrition. Working with both governments and businesses, we aim to transform food systems so that they deliver more nutritious food for all people. In particular, we aim to make healthier food choices more desirable, more available, and more affordable. GAIN's mission is to advance nutrition outcomes by improving consumption of nutritious and safe food for all people, especially the most vulnerable to malnutrition.

DESCRIPTION

Overall purpose

Following the invasion of Ukraine and the growing impact of climate change on global food supply, GAIN's work is in high demand. GAIN is working with potential new donors and developing its influencing agenda to try to achieve change in the food system in this demanding context, so it is more sustainable and pro-poor. Much of this work is led by the Executive Director (EDO).

GAIN urgently needs new support in this work to build capacity and impact. The role will be critical in supporting GAIN's influencing agenda, bringing skills to identify, evaluate, analyse, and present qualitative and quantitative data across the full extent of the food system; and also, in supporting proposals to donors.

Some of this work will require innovative thinking and new narratives about nutrition; scanning of the emerging ideas of partners and other actors in this space; interpreting GAIN's strategy and helping to translate this into proposals and presentations; and supporting and co-creating with the EDO analysis and preparation for:

- blogs and articles
- proposal concept notes, pitches and development
- external and internal presentation slides



Tasks and responsibilities

Analysis, writing and supporting proposals

- Conduct and deliver high quality analysis, writing and presentation support
- Carry out background research and evidence for a wide range of external and internal issues as needed
- Identify, research, analyse, prepare and/or organise information and briefing materials for the EDO to facilitate engagement in events and meetings
- Provide expert technical support and coordination for events involving the ED
- Prepare concept notes and pitches; co-author proposals, especially in early stage, and then going on to support design teams (working closely with the Development Office).
- Develop compelling, authoritative and evidence driven slides/presentations for a wide range of external and internal audiences

Communications

Provides communication support to the Executive Director

- Co-author blogs and articles
- Draft and review related communications and messages as needed
- Participate as appropriate in reports dissemination, via presentations, publications and other media as appropriate
- Represent GAIN during key industry discussions/presentations, while providing analysis, technical insights and disseminating lessons learnt.
- Support the EDO internal communications strategy across GAIN. Facilitate the coordination, planning implementation and delivery of internal communications initiatives
- Work with Comms professionals to find new and engaging modes of communicating
